

T50 Professional Access Control Reader

Do not use just


Do not slide your finger during the fingerpint verification process.

Operation Guide

Management mode: In original state, press [OK/M] then enter the admin password (Default password: 12345) to the management mode.




Add User:





Remarks: If register fails, the device will give a long 'Beep' voice to prompt. If the fingerprint has already been registered the device give two 'beeps' and voice prompts for the fingerprint process to be repeated.



■ Delete User: Press [0/→] key select [DEL.] option.



Setup Date and Time: Press [0/→] to select [TIME] option: Set time and date.



■ Management password setup: Press [0/→] to select [SET.] option: Change management password.




Remarks: If the second password does not match the first. When you press [OK/M] the device will give long beeps to indicate the password changing has failed.

Other Setup

Reset: Restarts Device


Press the 'Reset' button at the buttom of the device until LCD go out. Now release the button the device will restart.




Notice: Resetting will not delete any information or settings stored in the device.











Installation Diagram






■ Access Control Reader & Power Supply




■ Access Control Reader & Switch Power Supply




